How much will solar panels cost in China?

Analysts expect spot prices for solar modules to peak at CNY 0.73 (\$0.10)/W and averaging around CNY 0.70 (\$0.096)/W. Once the rush is over, prices may go down to CNY 0.70/W or even lower (see China's FIT Policy End To Push Up Prices Across PV Value Chain).

How much does a 5kw Solar System cost in China?

Prices have dropped significantly, but quality varies widely across suppliers and system types. A complete 5kW solar system in China costs $\$15,000-\$30,000$ (\$2,100-\$4,200), with Tier-1 panels from Longi or Jinko at $\$0.9-\1.3 (\$0.13-\$0.18) per watt. Installation adds 10-20% to the total price.
